A new sewer repair contract will start this week. Martin General Contractors will be doing the work

Martin will start on a valve replacement in the 3500 block of Hempstead Street. Traffic will often be restricted to one lane.

Later the week of October 17 or the week of October 24 they will replace valves at 3237 Rue Royale. Traffic on Rue Royale will intermittently be restricted to one lane and the entrance to the alley will be closed for several days. Drivers that use that alley need to enter the area from further south on Rue Royale. The sidewalk will also be closed for several days.

Other work will follow. Vacuum sewer canisters will be replaced at the following locations:

A sub-contractor will do directional boring to replace broken alarm conduit in the following locations:
